Incomplete Caries Removal

Incomplete caries removal can be defined as the partial removal of carious dentin on a tooth with no signs of irreversible pulpitis (is positive to cold, negative to percussion, no spontaneous pain, and no periapical lesion) and sealing the residual carious tissue with a final restoration.
